ABOUT THE SHOW



Written by Ian McCormack, *Cornflake* is a two-time award-winning experimental theatre piece that tells the story of two feral creatures turned treatment facility roommates as they try, refuse, accept, or chase change in a world where one must stay "normal".

At its core, Cornflake is about overcoming internal and external forms of ableism and homophobia to accept the authentic version of ourselves and to question why we laugh at people who are different.

Living in a world where one must forego desire, sexuality and identity, Bird (a cynical standup comedian) and Rat (a skittish salesperson) try to conform to the standards of their treatment facility: partaking in a newly mandated diet of cornflakes. Through sequences of poetry, movement, dry standup comedy and flight, Bird and Rat explore changing and being changed.
